CONFERENCE SPEAKERS

DALE A MATTHEWS, MD is Associate Professor of Medicine at Georgetown School of Medicine and a Senior Fellow at the National Institute for Healthcare Research. He practices and teaches general internal medicine and conducts research that includes the doctor-patient relationship, and the psychological and spiritual dimensions of medicine. Dr. Matthews is the author of : a four-volume work, The Faith



Factor: An annotated Bibliography of Clinical Research on Spiritual Subjects; two documentaries, Body, Mind, and Spirit, and Shall We Pray; an annotated, videotaped lecture on religion and medicine, The Faith Factor: Is Religion Good for your Health?; and over 55 peer-reviewed scientific articles, book chapters, and other publications.

FRANCIS S MACNUTT, PHD studied at Harvard and received a BA with honors. He then earned a mFA at Catholic University of America, entered the Dominican order and studied for the Roman Catholic priesthood. After ordination he earned a PhD in Theology from the Aquinas Institute of Theology. At a life-changing conference in Tennessee in 1967, Francis experienced the “baptism of the Spirit” and learned



about healing prayer with Rev. Tommy Tyson and Agnes Sanford. In this way, he became one of the first Roman Catholics to become involved in the Charismatic Renewal. In 1975, he was instrumental in founding the Association of Christian Therapists. Francis has authored best sellers: Healing, The Power to Heal, The Prayer that Heals, Overcome with the Spirit and Deliverance.

JUDITH SEWELL MACNUTT is a native of Kentucky with



a Master’s Degree in psychology, is a licensed psychotherapist and co-director with her husband, Francis, of Christian Heal Ministries, Inc. In her early twenties, Judith’s desire to minister the Gospel took her to Jerusalem, where she spent two years directing A House of Prayer, working with both Jews and Arabs. Moving to Florida in 1977, Judith founded

Christian Counseling Services, combining her work as a psychotherapist with healing prayer for her clients. In 1980, Judith married Francis and now travels with him extensively, counseling and speaking on the subject of inner hearing. They have co-authored Praying for the Unborn Child.

SUSAN STANFORD-RUE received her Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from Northwestern University in 1975. For 29 years, Dr. Stanford-Rue has been a practicing psychotherapist. She has served on the faculties of Northwestern University and Wayne State University, and as Academic Dean at Unity College in Maine. Dr. Stanford-Rue is the author of Will I Cry Tomorrow?, the dramatic story of psychological brokenness suffered



after her own abortion and how she was restored to wholeness through God’s forgiveness and healing love. She speaks nationally and internationally on the topic of Post-Abortion Syndrome and how women can find reconciliation and healing after the trauma of abortion. She is well known for her expertise in integrating the psychological and spiritual aspects of healing. Dr. Stanford-Rue has taught university level women’s courses and been active in women’s issues throughout her career. She has worked with numerous corporations doing staff development, team building, and conflict resolution. She serves on several national boards of directors, including Christian Healing Ministries in Florida and the Nurturing Network in California.

A block of rooms at special discount prices has been reserved at the **Bahia Resort Hotel, 998 E Mission Bay Drive, San Diego, CA 92109, 800-576-4229, www.bahiahotel.com**.
